


















Sketch of Diana's Crash Indicated 2nd Car - by Paul Kondis Within hours of the accident that killed Princess Diana, French investigators believed a second car might have been involved in the crash, the first official sketch of the scene shows. The diagram, obtained by the Associated Press, was made August 31, the day the crash occurred along the Seine River, and clearly shows a "monster truck" driving over the hood of the limousine that Princess Diana and her boyfriend, Dodi Fayed, were riding in. The truck, colored slate gray and with 5-foot tires of the type usually seen at Monster Truck and Tractor pulls, appeared to have been manufactured by "Tonka" and have a front grill that resembled sharks teeth holding a severed human leg. Also apparent from the sketch was that a very large creature, resembling the good monster character Godzilla from the movies, was in the tunnel, holding what appeared to be the Eiffel Tower. The Eiffel Tower has not been reported missing. Investigators are puzzled by a bizarre structure, resembling a series of concentric squares with a jagged roof and a squiggly wing, that appears to the right of the crash scene. Authorities have not been able to locate such a structure in the area.


