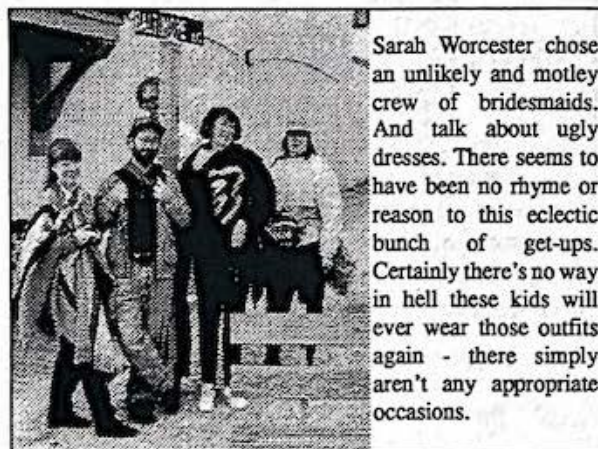
Steve Fossett and Richard Branson - Chicago millionaire and British tycoon team who failed in their attempt to circumnavigate the Earth in a big ol' balloon.

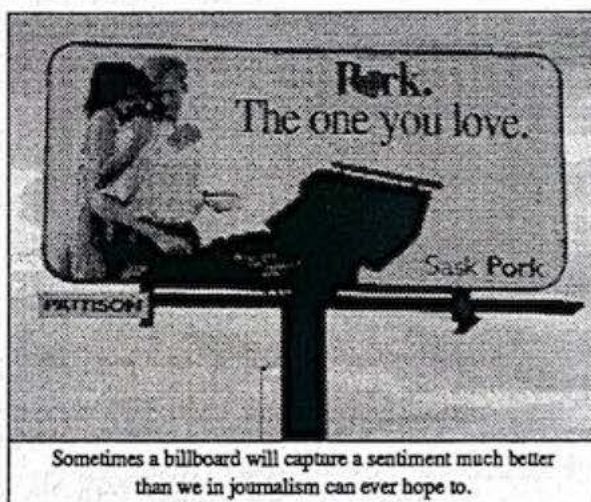

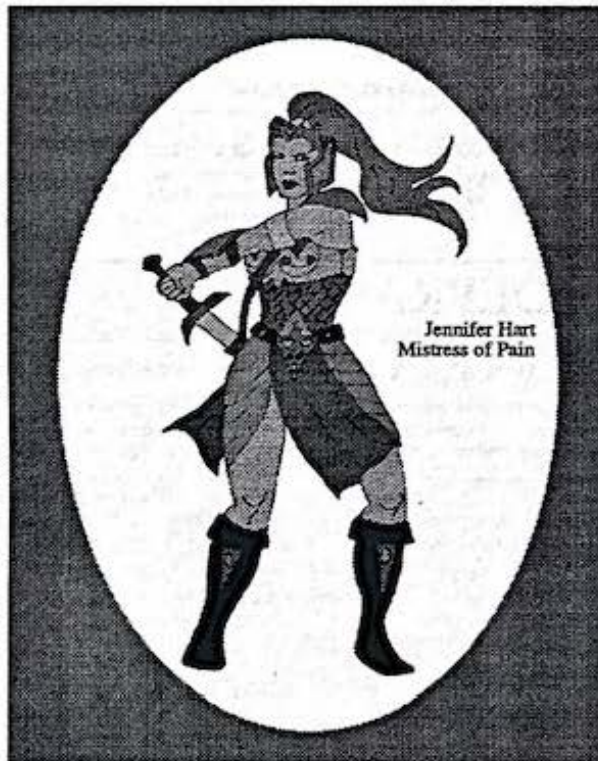
